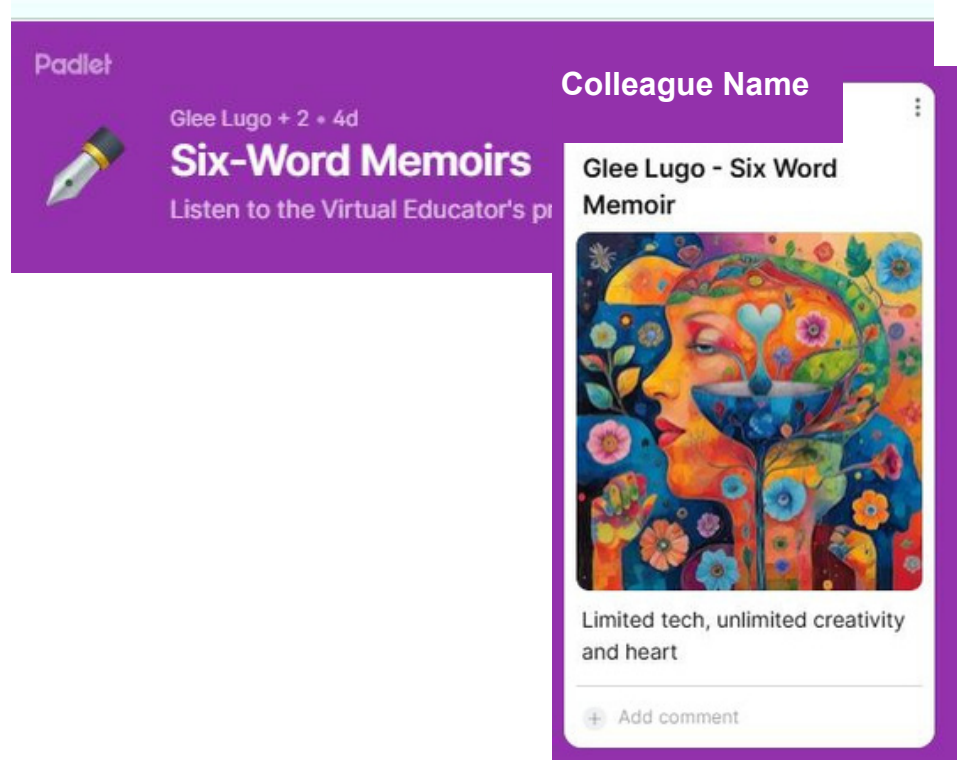

- Include an image to represent the memoir



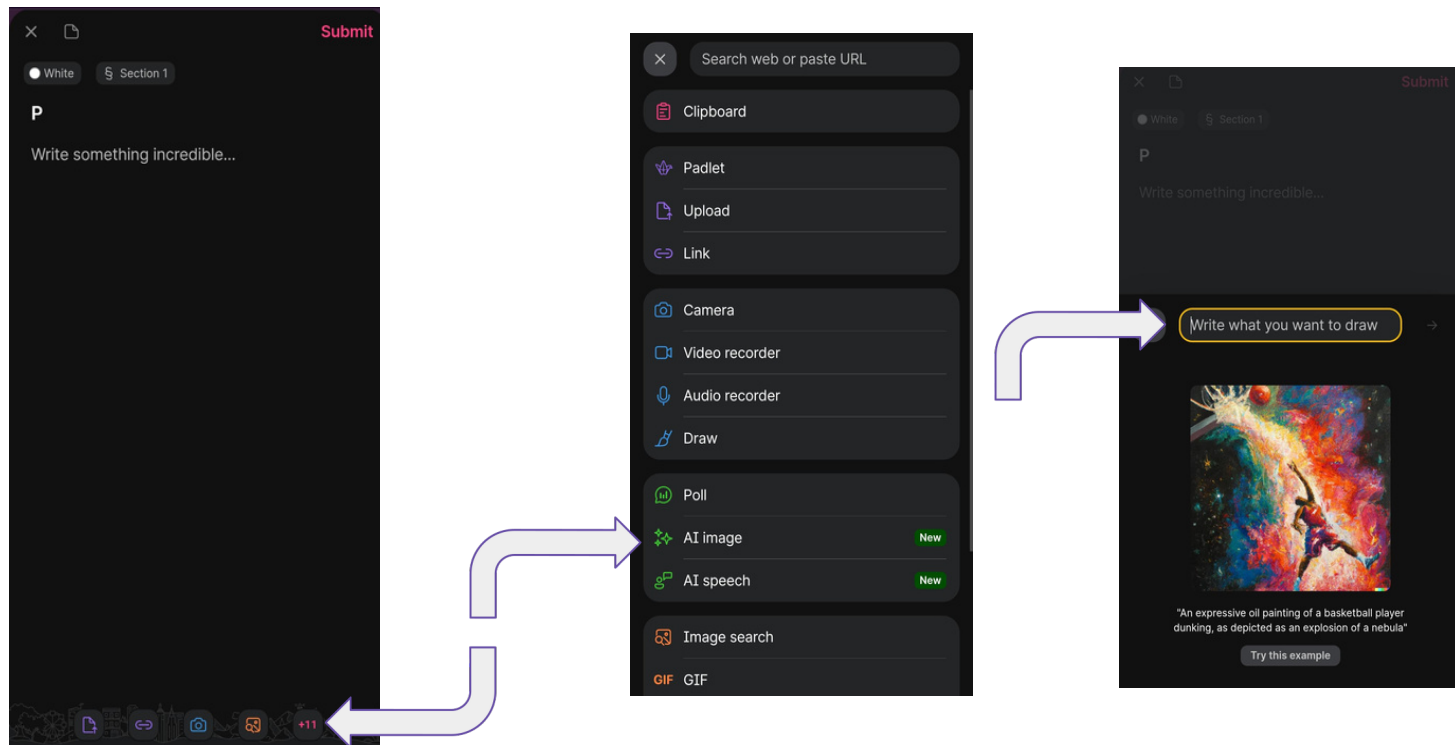
